## ORDINANCE No. O-2021-08

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CHANGE TO THE CITY OF WARD PERSONNEL HANDBOOK

WHEREAS, CITY OF WARD ORDINANCE O-2019-03 established the City of Ward Personnel Handbook which is applicable to all full-time, part-time and seasonal employees, and,

WHEREAS, STATE OF ARKANAS 93<sup>RD</sup> GENERAL ASSEMBLY ENACTED ACT 260 — An Act to Require a State Entity to Report a Security Incident to the Legislative Auditor; and for other purposes; and

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF WARD reserves the right to update the handbook from time to time as it becomes necessary.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF WARD, ARKANSAS** hereby declares the following changes be made to the City of Ward Personnel Handbook:

SECTION 1: Add paragraph "6.11.2.1 Cybersecurity Security Incident Reporting"

SECTION 2: Add paragraph "6.11.2.1.1 Duty to Report"

Employees MUST<sup>1</sup> as soon as possible, report any compromise of the security, confidentiality, or integrity of an information system maintained by the City of Ward, a contractual provider of information system that contracts with the City of Ward, or other computer-related services of the City of Ward, that is caused by any unauthorized:

- Access to an information system of the City of Ward;
- Destruction of an information system of the City of Ward or the data of an information system of the City of Ward;
- Acquisition of data from an information system of the City of Ward

**SECTION 3 – SEVERABILITY:** If, for any reason, any portion or portions of this ordinance shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall in no way affect the remaining portions.
