

ORDINANCE N No. O-2023-15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR CITY CLERK TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH “FAIRY CLEANING” CLEANING SERVICE TO PERFORM JANITORIAL SERVICES AT THE CITY HALL COMPLEX, REPEALING RESOLUTION 2022-41, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WARD authorized the Mayor or City Clerk to enter into a contract with “Fairy Cleaning” for janitorial services for the City Hall Complex via Resolution 2022-41; and,

WHEREAS, subsequent to signing the contract with “Get it Clean” it was determined that an Ordinance was needed to authorize a municipal employee to perform a service for the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARD THAT:

SECTION 1 – AUTHORIZATION: The Mayor or City Clerk is authorized to enter a contract (attached) with “Fairy Cleaning¹” for janitorial services for the City Hall Complex.

SECTION 2 - ACKNOWLEDGMENT: This contract is entered into with the full understanding by the Governing Body that the company is run by a current city employee – Melissa McNair – and that contractual services will only be conducted after normal work hours to include weekends².

SECTION 3 - TERMINATION: The contract may be terminated at any time for any reason as outlined in the attached.

SECTION 4 – REPEAL OF RESOLUTION 2022-41: Upon passage and posting, City of Ward Resolution R-2022-41 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5 – SEVERABILITY: If, for any reason, any portion or portions of this ordinance shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall in no way affect the remaining portions.

SECTION 6 – EMERGENCY CLAUSE: As this is a continuation of an existing signed contract, and to ensure the service continues without interruption, an emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance will take effect upon passage and posting.


