**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR THE CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF WARD TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO PURCHASE FIRE FIGHTER PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE) AND INFRARED CAMERAS**

**WHEREAS, THE CITY OF WARD** desires to ensure the safety of our fire fighters and remain in compliance with applicable state and federal laws along with rules established by the National Fire Protection Administration (NFPA).

**WHEREAS,** because Fire Fighter Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) has a mandatory usage life of ten (10) years per the NFPA, it becomes necessary for the City to purchase new PPE from time to time; and,

**WHEREAS,** the use of infrared cameras is common place in the Fire Service today; and,

**WHEREAS,** the current camera being used by Ward Fire Department is over 20 years old and cost more and more to maintain,


**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARD** hereby declares that the Mayor and/or the City Clerk may enter into a contract with David's Fire Equipment to purchase 6 (six) sets of PPE (Coat, Pant with suspenders, Gloves, Boots, with word "Ward" sew on the coat and each Firefighter's name (variable cost)). In addition, 2 (two) Infrared Cameras are covered in the contract. Further, a bid by said Contractor is hereby accepted in the amount of \$13,590.00 plus the cost of each Firefighter's last name on the coat tail (\$2.00 per letter).

Said resolution has been properly introduced and the vote was:


