A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR CITY CLERK TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GUYOT CONSTRUCTION, INC. TO COMPLETE THE WILLIARD ST/GERALDINE SEWER PROJECT

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF WARD Wastewater System operates on a vacuum system in various parts of the city which is not only outdated, but is also very labor intensive to maintain; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Governing Body of the City of Ward to remove every home from the Vacuum System; and,

WHEREAS, THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH has approved the plan to remove all houses on Willard Street and Geraldine Street from the Vacuum System and move them to a gravity system. This will reduce the number of homes on the Vacuum System by approximately 33%.

WHEREAS, GUYOT CONSTRUCTION, INC has submitted a quote to complete the project for \$29,657.00 (attached).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WARD THAT:

**SECTION 1:** Declares that Guyot Construction, Inc. is hereby awarded the contract to complete the project and authorizes the Mayor or City Clerk to sign any and all documents to execute same.

**SECTION 2:** The amount of \$29,656.00 is hereby approved and appropriated to complete the project and hereby waives the bid process as this company is the same company that constructed and installed the sewer infrastructure that this project will connect to.
