RESOLUTION R-2025-54**

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING TRI LAKES HAULING AND DAWSON ASPHALT AS THE LOW BIDDER TO OVERLAY SEVERAL STREETS AND THE CITY HALL PARKING LOT; AUTHORIZING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR CITY CLERK TO SIGN APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS FOR THE PROJECT

WHEREAS, PER RESOLUTION R-2025-24 THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WARD authorized the Mayor to enter into a contract with Bond Engineering for the purpose of engineering a project to overlay the City Hall Parking Lot¹ and the following streets:

- Stephens St (Dead End)
- Spencer St
- Kirkland St (Dead End)
- Hilburn St (Dead End)
- Grant St (Dead End)
- Circle B. Dr (Dead End)
- Marshal St from Grissom (Dead End)

WHEREAS BOND CONSULTING ENGINEERS properly published a Request for Proposal (bid request) and received six (6) proposals (attached) which were opened and read on November 18, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, BOND CONSULTING ENGINEERS certified Tri Lakes Hauling and Dawson Asphalt as the low bidder for the project with a bid of \$197,396.50 (attached).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF WARD, ARKANSAS, HEREBY DECLARES;

SECTION 1 – AWARD: That Tri Lakes Hauling and Dawson Asphalt be awarded the contract to overlay the areas noted above for an amount not to exceed \$197,396.50 – except as noted in Section 3 – and authorizes the Mayor and/or City Clerk to sign any and all documents to execute same.

SECTION 2 – FUNDING SOURCE: That the use of Street Department Funds is hereby approved and appropriated to complete the project and the respective budget amended thereto.

SECTION 3 – EXCESS FUNDING: That additional funds not to exceed 10% of the bid amount if needed for unforeseen changes and cost overruns are hereby authorized and appropriated.



Dear Mayor Gastineau,

We opened bids for the current street and city hall parking this morning at city hall. We received six bids for the projects. A certified bid tabulation is attached.

The bids range from a low of \$197,396.50 to a high of \$361,742.50. The low bidder is Tri Lakes Hauling. Marc Dawson, with Tri Lakes provided these references, Balboa Baptist Church, Horizon Senior Care, and City of Fountain Lake. It appears from comments that the company completed the projects but they were generally small. In my conversations with all the references they seemed reserved in their statements.

At least two of the references mentioned the age of their equipment. The largest project was for the City of Fountain Lake (\$110,000.00) and my conversation was with the wife of the reference.

Your project is relatively straight forward with existing street overlay being the majority of the work and some repairs.

The second low bidder, Roger's Group, is a local company well known in this area and the operator of their own hot mix asphalt plant. The second bidder is only \$4,445.96 higher.

I will be available to answer any questions concerning the award of this contract.
